The Great Wall of China is one of the most famous tourist attractions in the world. It's a very long wall that was built to keep out enemies from the north. The best time to visit this structure is between May and October when the weather is warm and there isn't too much rain. There are several different sections of the wall you can visit. Some are very busy with tourists, but others are much quieter. The most popular section is called Badaling. It's close to Beijing and has been open to tourists since the 1950s.
