Wind Power

Wind is a form of solar energy. It happens because the Sun heats different parts of the Earth unevenly. Wind moves in different directions because of mountains, water, and trees. People can use wind to create electricity by using wind turbines.

Wind turbines come in different sizes. The largest ones are as tall as a 20-story building and can **produce** enough electricity for 1,400 homes. Smaller wind turbines, with blades between 8 and 25 feet long, stand about 30 feet tall. They can generate power for a **modern** house or a small business. There are also very small wind turbines, producing less than 50 kilowatts of power. These are often used for homes, communication systems, or pumping water.
