

Some doctors say you should drink a glass of water every morning. Drink it as soon as you wake up, before doing anything else. The water should not be too hot or too cold, just comfortable for you.

Why is drinking water **important**? Water helps your body in many ways. **It** helps clean your kidneys, get your stomach ready to digest food, and helps your intestines work better. Drinking water also helps your intestines take nutrients from food. It also makes it easier to go to the bathroom.

Scientists have made significant progress in predicting natural disasters, which helps minimize the risks to people and property. Through research and technology, they can now predict earthquakes, hurricanes, floods, and volcanic eruptions, although the accuracy varies.

Earthquakes are difficult to predict because they occur suddenly and without warning. However, scientists use seismographs to monitor the Earth's movements. They track seismic activity to identify patterns and make predictions about areas where earthquakes are more likely.

Hurricanes are easier to predict. Meteorologists use satellite images to monitor storms as they form. By studying wind patterns, air pressure, and ocean temperature, scientists can predict where a hurricane will strike and how strong it will be.

Floods can be predicted by monitoring weather patterns and river levels. Scientists use radar systems and weather satellites to observe rainfall and track rising water levels. If water levels rise too quickly, there is a high risk of flooding.
