$$20 - 6 = 14$$

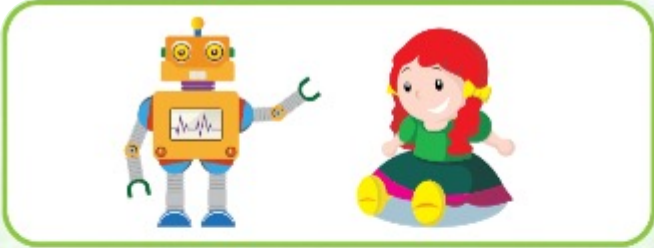
